A unique skyline in France, the La Défense district conceals a wealth of unimagined riches: an architecture of vertiginous towers, and a pedestrian esplanade populated with 70 works of art by Calder, Miró, and Cesar among others. At a height of 110 m, the panoramic viewpoint on the roof of the **Grande Arche** offers a breathtaking view. AT THE HEART OF ARTISTIC CREATION

The Western Paris region is a location of choice for many artists and has hosted prestigious sites of artistic and architectural creation from the 18th century to the present day: Le Musée Rodin, Sévres - cité de la Céramique, the Museum of the 1930s, La Défense and:

UNUSUAL DISCOVERIES

The Western Paris region also offers unexpected curiosities such as the collections of the amazing Musée français de la Carte à jouer or surprising places such as:

- **The vineyards** in Suresnes, no. 1 vineyard in Ile-de-France (the Paris region)
- **The Dog Cemetery** in Asnières-sur-Seine
- **The Musée Raybet Fould** situated in the Sweden/Norway Pavilion and the India Pavilion, both vestiges of the 1878 Universal Exhibition in Courbevoie
- **The Crayères des Montquartiers** (former chalk quarries) in Issy-les-Moulineaux = theatrical visits



NATURE IN THE CITY

With 45% of its territory covered by green spaces, the Hauts-de-Seine offers a privileged and unique environment in the immediate vicinity of Paris. These numerous islands of greenery are conducive to relaxation, leisure, and convivial moments with family and friends.

- **3 Forests domaniales**: forêt de Meudon, forêt de la Malmaison, forêt de Fosses-Reposes
- **18 municipal parks and gardens with a wide variety of atmospheres**
- **400 of signposted itineraries offer numerous opportunities for bucolic walks and sporting hikes**
- **Three cycling routes** also traverse the Department:
 - **The London to Paris "Avenue Verte"** from Villeneuve-la-Garenne to Rueil-Malmaison along the banks of the Seine, which follows the "Promenade Bleue" route
 - **Seine à Vélo**, from Paris to Le Havre or Honfleur
 - **The Paris to Mont-Saint-Michel "Vélascénia"** which joins with the "Promenade des Vallons" along the River Bièvre, from Poite de Vanves to Antony

ALONG THE WATERFRONT

The Seine is an omnipresent component of the Hauts-de-Seine landscape featuring 66 km of riverbanks that are gradually being redeveloped for walking and leisure activities. Stretching the length of the river:

- **Countless restaurants** along the waterfront...
- **The Ile de Monsieur water sports park** in Sèvres
- **The Promenade bleue**, from Reuil-Malmaison to Colombes
- **The Vallée rive gauche**, from Issy-les-Moulineaux to Sèvres
- **The river port of Gonnevilliers** (river visit from April to October)



Musée national du château de Malmaison

A private residence of Bonaparte and Joséphine under the Consulate, the Château de Malmaison still reflects the splendour of this period. The elegant decor, designed by Percier and Fontaine, is admirably preserved, in particular the room in which the Empress died in 1814.

Domaine national de Saint-Cloud

This exceptional site overlooking the River Seine, houses a château that was the residence of the various royal and imperial families from the 16th century onwards. Its 400 hectares of gardens, parks and wooded areas provide one of the finest examples of classical garden art and offer superb views of the capital.

Musée départemental Albert-Kahn

The site illustrates the banker Albert Kahn's humanist project and his ideal of peace through a fabulous collection of early colour photographs. The gardens bring together plant species from all five continents of the globe. The museum is currently under renovation, soon to present a refurbished site that will open in 2019. Le Mont-Valérien, haut lieu de mémoire nationale

The site was chosen by General de Gaulle to honour the French who died between 1939 and 1945. The monument houses a crypt where 16 members of the armed forces and the French Resistance are laid to rest. A poignant footpath follows the path followed by the 1,000 patriots who were executed on the site.

Musée Rodin

Dominating the Seine, the Villa des Brillants became Rodin's refuge in 1895. The house reveals the master's private quarters and presents his collection of antiquities. The workshop preserves the studies and sketches of his greatest masterpieces. The garden houses Rodin's tomb, beneath the famous "Penseur" (Thinker) sculpture.

Musée et parcours des Années 30

The Museum of the 1930s proposes a wonderful evocation of the artistic profusion of the inter-war period, through an exceptional collection of paintings, sculptures, and Art-deco furniture. A marked path through Boulogne-Billancourt enables visitors to discover a unique set of creations by Le Corbusier, Auguste Perret, and Mallet Steevens, all pioneers of modern architecture.

Domaine départemental du Haras de Jarjay

Jarjay stud farm, built at the end of the 19th century in the Anglo-Norman style, offers visitors a bucolic setting. Its century-old stables, meadows and tree-lined bridle paths are home to one of the first equestrian centres in France. The site also offers a golf course (9-hole) and several tennis courts.

Parc nautique départemental de l'île de Monsieur

Located on the outskirts of Paris and on the banks of the Seine, this environmentally friendly park offers 7.5 hectares of green space dedicated to sports and leisure activities. It is designed to resemble a small Scandinavian port, with wooden decking, slipways and pontoons facilitating access to the river. The water sports park offers visitors a refreshing change of scenery.
